EOC Hours of Operation: 07:30 am to 10:00 pm (Mon-Fri) and 9:00 am to 5:00 pm (Sat-Sun)

1. Situation Summary

a. First Nations Communities

- (1) 26 open, 8 closed to non-essential staff/supplies, and 29 closed.
- (2) 31 health facilities open, 29 offering limited services, 9 closed.

b. Winnipeg

- (1) City-owned parks remain open, but amenities inside the parks including play structures and picnic shelters are closed.
- (2) City will not enforce the parking time limit restrictions in residential areas to accommodate employees who are now required to be home for longer periods of time due to self-isolation and work from home requirements.

c. Manitoba

- (1) Public health officials advise the total number of lab-confirmed positive and presumptive COVID-19 cases in Manitoba is now 72. Most cases still appear related to either travel or exposure to known cases. One case has died, two cases are in hospital, and two cases have recovered. No cases have been identified in First Nations communities.
- (2) Public gatherings in Manitoba are now limited to no more than 10 people at any indoor or outdoor place or premises. This includes places of worship, gatherings and family events such as weddings and funerals. Retail businesses including grocery or food stores, shopping centres, pharmacies or gas stations must ensure separation of one to two meters between patrons. Public transportation facilities must also ensure that people are able to maintain a separation of one to two metres. This change does not apply to places where social services and/or health care are provided, homeless shelters, or workplaces.
- (3) Five provincial border checkpoints are now in place where travelers are informed about the risk of COVID-19 and the need for self-isolation.

2. FNIHB Regional Activities

- a. Worked with DOTC to arrange for isolation of two inter-provincial travelers from one of their communities who arrived in Winnipeg from outside the province. Closed.

- b. Monitor first shipments of isolation kits by CRC to 15 FN communities and one Tribal Council. Isolation kits include cots, pillows, blankets, and wash kits, with PPE to be added shortly. Ongoing.
 - c. Confirm numbers of PPE required by personal care homes on FN communities and place orders. Ongoing.
 - a. Clarify with FN communities as required:
 - (1) Operationalization of provincial public health orders on-reserve. Ongoing.
 - (2) Notification process for COVID-19 cases or contacts (same as existing reporting process for communicable diseases). Ongoing.
 - (3) How to support the return of patients to FN communities who attend essential medical appointments off-reserve. Ongoing.
