The Cook follows established menus and nutrition care directions and ensures therapeutic diets, allergies, food intolerances, and texture-modified diets are prepared accurately.

POSITION DUTIES:

- Prepare, cook, bake, portion, and serve meals, snacks, beverages, and nourishments according to established menus, recipes, schedules, and portion standards.
- Prepare therapeutic diets and texture-modified foods according to Resident diet requirements and care plans.
- Follow food allergy, intolerance, food safety, and cross-contamination precautions.
- Complete required food production, temperature, cooling, cleaning, and other food service records.
- Maintain clean and sanitary food preparation, storage, service, and dishwashing areas.
- Safely operate kitchen equipment and follow established Safe Work Procedures.
- Support Resident preferences, cultural and traditional foods, and special occasions as appropriate.
- Work collaboratively with Dietary Aides, nursing staff, the Registered Dietitian, and other members of the care team.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Grade 10 education or equivalent.
- Current Food Handler Certificate recognized in Manitoba.
- Valid Class 5 Driver's License.
- Reliable means of transportation to and from the workplace
- Clear Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Persons Sector, Adult Abuse Registry Check, and Child Abuse Registry Check.
- Knowledge of therapeutic diets, food allergies and intolerances, portion control, and texture-modified foods.
- Ability to read and understand menus, recipes, diet information, and safety instructions.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Physically and mentally able to perform the duties of the position.
- Post-secondary education in institutional cooking, culinary arts, or a related food services program is preferred. Relevant education and experience will be considered.
- Experience preparing meals in long-term care, health care, seniors housing, or another institutional setting is preferred.
