Employment Opportunity Dog Control Officer Full-Time, Term

Position Summary: The Dog Control Officer is responsible for enforcing the community's animal control regulations, specifically related to dogs, ensuring public safety, and promoting responsible pet ownership within Sioux Valley Dakota Nation. The Dog Control Officer will work closely with community members, leadership, and other stakeholders to address concerns about dog behavior, welfare, and public safety.

The position involves patrolling designated areas, responding to complaints or incidents involving dogs, educating community members on animal care, and carrying out enforcement measures in a respectful and culturally sensitive manner.

Key Responsibilities:

- Monitor and enforce the community's dog-related laws and regulations, including licensing, leash laws, and safety ordinances.
- Respond promptly to complaints or concerns regarding dogs, including nuisance behavior, attacks, and stray animals.
- Capture and impound dogs that are in violation of regulations, ensuring the safe return of the animals or responsible rehoming.

- Other duties as deemed necessary.
