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**Position Summary** The Recreation Coordinator is a community-facing role dedicated to improving the physical well-being of our youth. You will be the "engine" behind our after-school and weekend physical activity programs, transforming the school gymnasium into a hub of health, sportsmanship, and positive energy. This role requires someone who is self-motivated, organized, and passionate about inspiring the next generation to lead active lives.

**Why Join Us?** You will have the autonomy to build a culture of health from the ground up. This isn't just a gym-supervision job; it is a chance to directly impact the long-term health outcomes of our community's youth.

#### **Key Responsibilities**

- **Facility Management:** Oversee the opening, operation, and security of the gymnasium during evening and weekend hours. Ensure all equipment is maintained and the environment remains safe for all participants.
- **Sports Development:** Design, launch, and manage organized community sports leagues (e.g., basketball, volleyball, soccer) tailored to various age groups.
- **Health Advocacy:** Create and implement initiatives specifically aimed at improving the overall physical health of local youth, moving beyond just sports to include general fitness and movement.
- **Community Outreach:** Actively promote healthy living through workshops, social media, or community events. Be the "face of fitness" for the Education Department.
- **Mentorship:** Foster a positive, inclusive environment where youth feel encouraged to participate regardless of their skill level.
- **Adaptive Support:** Perform other community-related duties as they arise to support the evolving needs of our families and students.

#### **Required Qualifications & Skills**

- **Communication:** Strong ability to connect with kids, parents, and community leaders.
