In instances where the instructional resource teacher is working in a classroom with students with exceptionalities, he or she may also support the learning of other students as opportunities arise. The duties and responsibilities of the resource teacher are in keeping with the Consultative/Collaborative model of special education services delivery.

**DUTIES INCLUDE:**

- Act as a member of a multi-disciplinary team, which may include parents, child, classroom teacher, para-educator(s), school administration, and other internal or external professionals.
- Direct and provide support services to the classroom teacher, students and parents.
- Manage and coordinate the special education services within the school.
- Classroom assignment and/or small group facilitator.
- To ensure that all resource files are completed, including historical and current documents.
- Establish goals and share with staff
- Conduct pre-referral conferences
- Conduct classroom observations and follow up conferences
- Conduct program planning conferences
- Monitor program implementation
- Conduct assessments and make recommendations
