Employment Opportunity Health Centre Community Health Representative Full-Time, Term

Position Summary: The Community Health Representative works under the supervision of the Nurse in Charge at the Sioux Valley Health Centre. This role is pivotal in delivering a wide range of public health programs to the Sioux Valley Dakota Nation community, in close cooperation with Community Health Nurses and other health representatives.

Duties & Responsibilities

1. Home Visits & Client Support

- Schedule and prioritize home visits based on client needs.
- Observe client environments, identify risks, report to Community Health Nurse, and make referrals.
- Provide health teaching, counselling, and distribute education materials.

2. Clinic & Class Support

- Promote clinics and classes to target groups and support accessibility.
- Assist Community Health Nurses with screenings, exams, and teaching during clinics/classes.
- Provide reception for visiting clinicians and itinerant health staff.
- Assist at the Brandon High School Teen Clinic as scheduled.
- Coordinate with external health organizations (e.g., Diabetes, Heart Health, Pharmacy, Dieticians).
- Support auditory services (Keystone Hearing).
- Work with the Nurse Practitioner on scheduled days.

3. Communicable Disease Prevention & Intervention

- Monitor for communicable disease risks and report promptly for follow-up action.
- Deliver prevention teaching and counselling to clients and the community.
- Promote sanitary practices and provide HIV/AIDS and Tuberculosis support, including medication assistance and resources.

4. Support for Expecting Mothers (CPNP)

- Deliver prenatal/postnatal classes and workshops.
- Provide in-home and school presentations on prevention, health, and nutrition.
- Promote skill-building, breastfeeding, and healthy development for mothers and infants.
- Provide one-on-one and group CPNP support, including home visits.
- Develop support programs and advocate for ongoing community planning in maternal health.

5. Community Education & Awareness

- Promote Healthy Lifestyle initiatives.
- Coordinate nutritional cooking classes and wellness workshops.
- Improve access to nutrition information and encourage healthy living.

6. Collaboration with Community Health Programs

- Support the health needs of women, respecting cultural traditions and values.
- Meet regularly with health staff for networking and program coordination.
- Work with mothers and Elders to incorporate cultural practices.
- Collaborate with other health programs to strengthen CPNP services.

7. Environmental Health Activities

Conduct environmental health inspections as assigned.

8. Reporting & Program Administration (CPNP)

- Prepare and submit quarterly work plans and program reports to the Health Director.
- Report activities, statistics, issues, and recommendations as required by funding agreements.
- Participate in CPNP program evaluations and submit all reports for review and approval.

Qualifications:

- Certificate or diploma in Community Health, Health Care Aide, Public Health Support, or a related field (an equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered).
- Experience working in community health programs, maternal/child health, or public health settings.
- Knowledge of prenatal, postnatal, nutrition, and early childhood development.
- Understanding of communicable disease prevention, health promotion, and environmental health practices.
- Strong organizational skills with the ability to maintain accurate records, reports, and documentation.
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively with Community Health Nurses, external agencies, and community members.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills, with sensitivity to cultural values, traditions, and community protocols.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality and adhere to health policy and program guidelines.
- Computer proficiency (E-Chart, Telehealth, databases, email, reporting systems).
- Valid Class 5 driver's licence and access to a reliable vehicle.
- Ability to handle and transport hazardous materials safely (training provided or willingness to obtain).
- Current CPR/First Aid certification or willingness to obtain.
