Position Summary: The Sioux Valley Dakota Nation Community Gardener is responsible for assisting in preparing and maintaining the community gardens, greenhouse and Growcer unit. Main duties will include sanitation and working outdoors with the Greenhouse, Gardens & Grasslands Manager and Garden Supervisors. This is a term position (April 2026- October 2026)

Position Duties:

- Adhere to the standards & requirements of the Employee Policy Handbook; and to the standards of the Canada GAP Food Safety Manual for Greenhouse Products
- Assist in planting vegetables, flowers, trees, and native plants and properly maintaining the health and vitality of plants
- Assist Supervisors in cleaning the greenhouse, Growcer, headerhouse and outdoors, and keeping the site clean and free from hazards
- Assist Supervisors in proper plant care (watering, weeding, fertilizing, and pest control); Help prepare, plant, water, harvest, and distribute produce; with the use of hand tools, power tools and other equipment
- Assist with organizing and facilitating workshops; tours, and events held by the SVCGP (Sioux Valley Community Garden Program).
- Other related tasks & duties assigned by the coordinator

- Must be reliable, dependable; can work weekends if needed

- Willingness to teach others about garden care
