Position Summary: Sioux Valley Dakota Nation is seeking an individual for the position of Expanded Trauma-Informed Support Worker to provide trauma-informed, culturally safe support to individuals and families impacted by intergenerational trauma. This role supports wellness, healing, and system navigation through compassionate, client-centred, and community-based services.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide trauma-informed emotional support to individuals experiencing crisis, grief, or distress
- Support clients through challenging processes such as trauma disclosure, claims, or major life stressors
- Assist individuals with referrals and navigation of mental health, addictions, medical, cultural, and social services
- Advocate for client needs and help reduce barriers to accessing care
- Support culturally respectful and Indigenous-centered approaches to wellness and healing
- Assist with group programming, healing circles, workshops, and wellness activities
