# Employment Opportunity Jordan's Principle Clinical Counsellor Full-time

**About the Role**: We are seeking a qualified and compassionate **Clinical Counsellor** to provide professional therapeutic counselling services to children, youth, and families through the Jordan's Principle Program at Sioux Valley Dakota Nation. This role delivers culturally safe, trauma-informed clinical services including assessment, treatment planning, therapeutic intervention, and crisis support. The Clinical Counsellor works collaboratively within a multidisciplinary team to support holistic mental health and family wellness

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Conduct clinical assessments to identify emotional, behavioural, psychological, and social needs.
- Develop individualized treatment plans based on evidence-based therapeutic approaches.
- Provide counselling using recognized modalities such as CBT, play therapy, narrative therapy, EMDR, and attachment-based practices.
- Deliver short-term and long-term counselling services to children, youth, and families.
- Provide crisis intervention, stabilization, and safety planning when required.
- Maintain professional boundaries and uphold ethical clinical standards.
- Collaborate with families, caregivers, educators, and community supports.
- Participate in multidisciplinary meetings with SLPs, OTs, Child & Youth Counsellors, nurses, and other professionals.
- Maintain accurate clinical documentation, case notes, and consent forms.
- Prepare reports for referrals, funding compliance, and case coordination.
- Support community-based mental health initiatives, land-based healing, and wellness programming.
- Provide psychoeducation and mental health workshops to families and staff as needed.

### Qualifications:

- Master's degree in Counselling, Psychology, Social Work (MSW), Marriage & Family Therapy, or a related field.
- Registration or eligibility for registration with a recognized professional body (e.g., MCSW, CCPA, or equivalent).
- Minimum two (2) years of clinical counselling experience with children, youth, and families.
- Training in trauma-informed and culturally grounded therapeutic approaches preferred.
- Experience working in First Nations or Indigenous communities is a strong asset.
