This role supports literacy, numeracy, homework completion, and study skills while helping youth build confidence, motivation, and a positive connection to learning. The Male Tutor also serves as a positive role model, promoting responsibility, cultural respect, and school engagement

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide one-on-one or small-group tutoring in core subjects such as reading, writing, math, and science.
- Support students with homework, assignments, studying, and organization skills.
- Reinforce effective study habits, time management, and school engagement.
- Serve as a positive male role model and mentor to boys and young men.
- Encourage confidence, motivation, and healthy attitudes toward learning and personal responsibility.
- Support youth in setting and achieving academic goals.
- Identify learning gaps and adapt teaching strategies to meet individual learning needs.
- Work collaboratively with school staff, families, and program staff when appropriate.
- Participate in Jordan's Principle programming, youth activities, and educational events.
- Integrate culturally respectful approaches into learning and mentorship.
- Maintain session notes, attendance records, and learning progress updates.
- Provide regular updates to supervisors and contribute to Jordan's Principle reporting.

- Experience tutoring or working with children or youth required.
- High school diploma required; post-secondary education or training in education, teaching, literacy, or tutoring is an asset.
- Experience working in First Nations or Indigenous communities is an asset.
- Strong knowledge of core academic subjects.
- Patient, empathetic, and able to motivate students.
- Strong communication, teaching, and adaptability skills.
- Ability to build trust and positive relationships with boys and young men.
